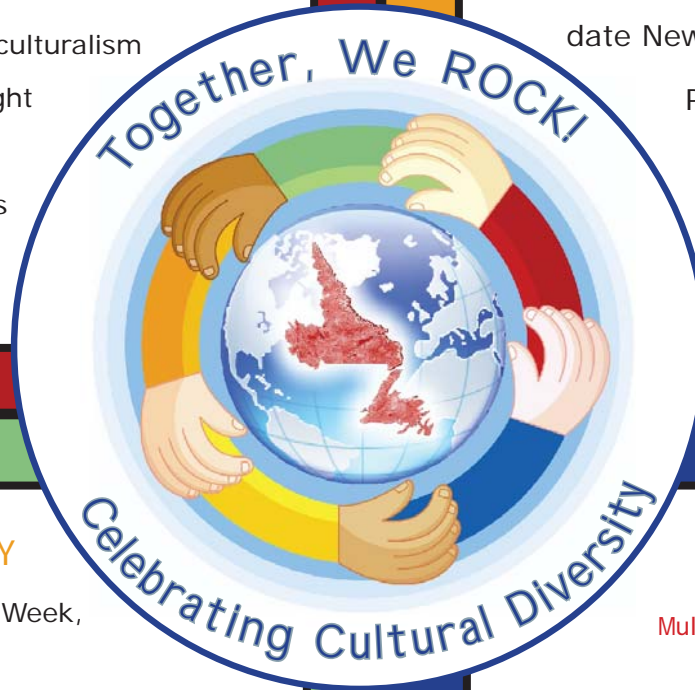


## HOW CAN YOU PARTICIPATE
